PROGRAM FEATURES

As part of Game Changer, your sporting club or community group will receive:

1. **Development of an emerging leader:** EML will fund a young adult to enrol in a TAFE Certificate IV in Leadership and Management.
2. **Mental health first aider:** EML will fund a representative of your club or group to complete a nationally accredited certificate.
3. **Outside the Locker Room:** a welfare and education program involving individual mentoring and public workshops on social issues such as, drug and alcohol abuse, mental health, suicide prevention, domestic violence and health & nutrition.

CERTIFICATE IV IN LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT

DEVELOP A LOCAL EMERGING LEADER BY NOMINATING ONE YOUNG ADULT TO BUILD LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT SKILLS IN A RANGE OF ENTERPRISE AND INDUSTRY CONTEXTS.

The TAFE SA Certificate IV in Leadership and Management is a 12-month (March-October) course, equipping students with the skills to supervise teams of personnel, provide leadership and guidance to others, and manage and build an effective team. Attendance is one day per month for the duration. All participating clubs/groups are invited to nominate a representative aged between 18-35. One student per club/group will be funded by EML.

MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID

WOULD YOU KNOW HOW TO SPOT THE SIGNS OF A MENTAL HEALTH CONDITION IN A COLLEAGUE OR FRIEND? NOMINATE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM YOUR CLUB/GROUP FOR TRAINING IN MENTAL HEALTH FIRST AID AND HELP TRANSFORM THE WELLBEING OF YOUR CLUB AND COMMUNITY. THE IDEAL NOMINEE IS SOMEONE WHO KNOWS MOST OR MANY MEMBERS OF YOUR CLUB OR GROUP.

Your club representative will learn about the signs and symptoms of common mental health problems. Through training they will be equipped with the skills to provide initial help and guidance to access professional help. The training is delivered over two days, one club representative will be funded by EML.

Outside The Locker Room (OTLR) is a 12-month commitment to your sporting club.

It consists of mentoring for players and four workshops targeting the wider club membership on topics such as:

- Mental health
- Drug and alcohol use
- Domestic violence
- Suicide prevention
- Nutrition
